I have the Cthulu, and it's pretty great. The paint job isn't perfect, but the detail in teh sculpt is extremely well done, very textured and funky, not smooth boring plastic. There is even a little articulation in the arms, and the tentacles are bendy.

Oh, and incidentally -- I have a black version of him, done as an exclusive through a particular distributor. I checked New England Comics in Harvard Sq, they had two Cthulus and a Ghoul. I checked Govt Centre Newbury Comics and they had 2 Cthulus and a Ghoul.
