They look cool in all of the DF set-ups (DOE, Cavern, M.B.S. etc). Beautiful color contrast, actually! I think someone mentioned earlier that they were pricey --To me, they were worth the money. The walls really enhance the minis too: Demon behind Fire Walls; Ice Elemental behind Ice Walls; Dragon behind Smoke Walls...too cool to describe here! The walls look sweet, for sure...but the smaller ones look just as good and are going to be very useful to show smaller fires, explosions, poison clouds, etc. I wish I had a digital camera!
