I use a basic transparent glue (polyprene)

The half bow ties are hard to fix since the holes are too huge or too thin so the result isn't perfect. But if you watch the pieces one step away it looks ok.

The result is ... kif kif like we say in french it means it's not very good. (50% 50%)

The hardest part is when you need to rip some borders with a knife because bow-ties & bow-tie holes aren't perfect.

I should paint them all with the same color but it's too complicated to get the same color and it takes definitively too much time.

Well after 6 hours to work on the half bow ties of all my DF pieces I have finally finished this task. So Here what I've done working hard in 6 hours:

- 1 room set
- 1 deluxe room
- 1 room & passage set
- 1 octagonal room set
- 1 narrow passage set
- 1 advanced builder set
- 1 trap set 1
- 1 trap set 2
- 1 fantasy floor set
- 1 fantasy starter set
- 1 wicked 1 set
- 1 wicked 2 set
- 1 15 short passage set
- 4 croisements T
- 4 passages X
- 1 cavern set
- 1 cavernous passage set

What I had to do:

- 1 To buy 9 half bow ties packs it means 900 half bow ties
- 2 To place it and paste it with a transparent glue (a superglue isn't good at all & expensive) ad let all the DF pieces dry one month.
- 3 To Buy a Drennel.
- 4 To put my protection glasses. (cinema 3D are good too :lol:)
- 5 Patience & précision in 6 hours.

Final count: I spent close to 20 hours between pasting and ripping.

I even scored the line so the finishing touch is perfect.
