It is "a scaly biped 70 feet long and 50 feet tall, with two horns on its head, a lashing tail, and a reflective carapace. It weights about 130 tons." (yes, I realize this doesn't describe the pic I posted...)

I'm not a terrasque expert, I consider it basically a Really Big Magical Monster. It's something some minis fans really want to see, so this is a decent substitute. The key is Big and Biped.
