Hi Myrthe,

yes you can upload images with that function that you probably allready found (it's only available in the post reply section not in the quick post).

You select the number of photos you want to upload in the Image Upload section and then browse to the images.

Before doing so, you should ensure that limit requirements are met (each image must be less then 1600x1200 pixels and 512 KB). Then simply hit Submit.

As you already discovered, it seems that the Preview function does not show images. It is presumably because they must be uploaded before that could work, and well, then it's no longer a preview regarding the image. So Preview is only related to the text part. Also the upload can take some seconds until being finished, e.g. if many large pics are uploaded.

If you have to reduce image size before uploading, use a graphics program of your choice. Look out for a function like 'rescaling' or '(changing) image size'. If you don't have one and don't want to buy one I can recommend GIMP (again :D) See http://www.gimp.org.

If you take shots with a digital camera and your only intention is to post it here, you may also just adjust the camera options to shoot images of an appropriate size. Unless you use a actual profi, semi-profi or other brandnew high-resolution model, where usually even the lowest resolutions are to big to be posted here, you can avoid the extra effort for downscaling.

Did you check the file format of the image?

I am not totally sure which formats work well. Presumably all with appropriate MIME types should work, but who knows.

We know at least that .jpg and .png seem to work. I think .gif should also work.

You only need an on-line-image-hosting site when you use the img-tag variant described above.
