The Reaper Master Series HD line works amazingly well. Good for base layer, washes and dry rushing. Unfortunately that is not the line in the Kickstarter. Those are the regular Master Series. Which are still good but more transparent, you need to layer up for complete coverage. Still, I ordered three sets to complement my HD paints. You can get the entire HD line in two sets that retail for \$50 or so, cheaper on eBay.

For glue, try Games Workshop glue. Made for minis.
