Of course you will have to block off the open ends of the hallway pieces. Perhaps with pieces from Advanced Builder (or is it ABS 2?).

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There is nothing in either Advanced Builder Set that will help make a round room.

The inside wall of the Curved Passage piece is the same as a Curved Wall piece. In order to use the outside wall of the Curved Passage piece, you would have to cut it up.

Four Curved Wall pieces can be used with Straight Wall pieces and doors to make a round(ish) room six squares across.

Some of us hope to someday inspire, convince, bribe, or hypnotize Stefan to make a 4x4 Large Curved Wall piece for MasterMaze.
